Resolved unanimously

That we whose names are undersigned will endeavour
to the best of our knowledge will endeavor to prevail
on the Labourers of this Parish to come forward at this
momentous crisis as pioneers & drivers of Cattle &

That we will assist them with tools &c &c
To go anywhere within 10 Miles of the Parish ~~as far as~~
but with their own Consent.

That we appoint W^r John Compton of Chisenbury
in the Parish of Enford Captain of Pioneers that we
approvve & have the highest Confidence in him

That we have entered our Waggon & Horses & that
we will do all that lies in our Power to Assist
Government - to maintain good order - & quell all
kind of riot - & assist the Peace officers &c in doing their
Duty - &c
