One thousand pounds each as Capital
W. Hunt to superintend the establishing
the same and his Son Henry to Manufacture
the Blacking -

W. Hunt to take one half of the profits
for himself and Son and J^r. Charles
Walseley and W. Hare to take one quarter
of the profits each. - Proper and Legal
agreement to be drawn up in Paris
agreeable to the French Law -
