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Final concord at Westminster, the morrow  
of St. Martin, 4th Edward, son of Henry, before  
the King's justices(named) between Robert de Burgate  
plaintiff, & Roger Golafre, defendant, concerning a  
messuage & 20 acres of land in Melles, Roger recognized  
that tenement with appurtenances belonged to Robert  
as of gift of said Roger, & Robert granted to Roger  
the tenement, etc. & also 20 acres of land in the same  
village, of which 15 acres abut toward the south on  
that cultivated land(cultura) which is called Smythescroft  
& 5 acres lie in th cultivated land called Bondestoft &  
abut in the road called Haraldesgateweye, with that  
road as far as it goes from the place called Logbusk(?)  
toward the south, for which Roger gives a clove pink at  
Easter for sole service, but after his death the messuage  
& land etc. shall revert entire to Robert, to be held of the  
capital lords of the fee by the services that belong to it.  
Names of justices: Rober de Seyton(?), Ralph de Frenyngham,  
Thomas Welond, John Lovetoft, Roger de Leycester(?)
