Charter in which Henricus de Capell grants to  
Lady Beatrice de Burgate for 16<sup>marcs</sup> sterling 15 acres of  
~~arable~~<sup>meadow</sup> land called Smithestoft which lies between the  
swamp(mora) of Burgate & Gernecroft; & in Overwente from  
Smithestoft 2½ acres of land, which extends through the  
land of the hospital & abuts on the land of Sir Robert de  
Burgate toward the north, & a toft in the village of Melles  
called Coggelestoft, which is computed to contain about  
2½ acres & a rod(rod) called Grenerode which extends  
between Portweie on one side & Cogelleswode on the other  
& lies between the lands of Robert, son of Matilda, and  
a pond?(mara) called Chocheresmere. Witnesses: Sir

de Burgate, William de Bosco, Martin Gulofre, Thomas de
