Wm. de Stebbinge to Walter son of Benedict de Ponte of Redgrave for his homage and service 5 acres of land with appurtenances lying in the fields of Burgate to give, sell, or will as he wishes except to a house of religion, rendering annually 2s. in 2 payments, 12d. at the feast of St. Michael and 12d. at Easter, for all services to the king, and for scutage to the king 20 s. 1d. Witnesses: Hugh son of John, James de Gedding, Roger son of Alan, Alan de Gislingham, John le Messag, Wm. "medico", Adam Cissor, John de Aula, et al. Seal.
