William le Bretoun of Burgate grants to Thomas Rector of the church of Burgate for 16s. sterling a rod of land in his field called Manewynis toft lying between the building of the Prior of Hartssend(?) & the land of Sir Robert de Burgate on the other side & abutting on the Common (planitien) of Burgate, for 1 penny of rent at Easter. Witnesses: Peter de Burgate, Adam ^Clissor, Bartholomew Warin, Godeman Unewyn, Walter Hefer(?) Philip Wigerous(?), Robert Formagen, Thomas Faber, Thomas Wynesend & others.
