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Final concord at Westminster morrow of St. John Baptist, 18th year of Edward, son of Edward, before king's justices(named) between Oliver de Wachesham & Robert le Carter, chap^{la}lin, plaintiffs, & Peter de Burgate, defendant. He acknowledges their right to the manor of Burgate as held by his gift & they in turn re-grant it to him to be held by the usual services of the capital lords of the fee. After his death it is to go entire to John de Swyneford & Agnes, his wife, & their heirs, & if John de Swyneford dies without heir, then to the heirs of Agnes. No date. 14c.
