Robert de Swynefford lord of Burgate to Walter de Ronghhey, Thomas le Keu of Burgate, chaplain, and Robert de Wortham, clerk, for a sum of money, a messuage containing one hundred and twenty four acres of land, one hundred and twenty-four acres of wood with appurtenances in Burgate which is called Burghhagh with free exit and entry, with trees, hedges, ditches, and all other commodities, and chattels.
