meadows, pasture, etc., without any rent except the manor of  
Burgate with appurtenances and the advowson of the church of  
Burgate of the same manor concerning which a fine is levied  
in the curia of the king between Robert de Swyneford and  
Margaret his wife, plaintiffs, and Edmund de Playford, vicar,
