Robert le Chapman, Andrew Warin, William de Wynefeld,
Robert de Wynfeld, William Osemund, John Jay & others.

Dated at Burgate Sunday next after the feast of the
^{July 10} Translation of St. Thomas the Martyr. 19 Edward III.
