of Saynt Marye next after the Day hote of whiche sayd summe
of two hundred ffre and eightsy poundes syx shillings
perlyng to y wente of his pmysses whiche shall dwe
at myselfe abysyd I the sayd John Wewfelton do bynde me
myne heire and issynd by this pente well
content and paye or ransome to be contented & payed y sayd Nicholas
his gernet or assynd I mmedy atty upon haſſurance of his pmyss
to be made to me y sayd John Wewfelton to myne gernet in witness
whereof I the sayd John Wewfelton have subscribed this bille in
my hand and sette my seal the daye and yere of our abeynance
and it is agreed betwene the sayd Nicholas baron of John Wewfelton
that I sayd John shall paye of y sayd summe abovenynten in hand y
summe of one hundred poundes by rett to y wente at myfdom next
to my next
