Be it knownen. by this presented that whereas ffrauncis Dodd citizen and woodmonger
of London by his indenture of lease bearinge date the two and twentieth daie of this instant month of October
for the Consideration herein mentioned did demise gramble and to farme lett unto Robert Emynd of Houghton in
the County of Suff yeman one partke or partell of grounde in Clementes Inn fieldes in the pise of St Clement &
dayned in the County of Midd ad yd was then sevred with a sufficient fence, measured and bounded out from one &
other partke or partell of ground then in the occupation of the said ffrauncis Dodd beinge pte of the plott of grounde
whih the saide ffrauncis Dodd holdeth by a former lease made unto him from Sir John Holles of Houghton in the
County of Nottingham knight, and the Lady Ann his wife do hold unto the said Robert Emynd his executors and
assignes from the feaste of Saint Michael than hangle then last past before the date hereof for the terme of
Mynteche yarde and one quarter of a yeaire ad by the saide Indenture maye more at large appear **NOWE**
knowe yet that if the said Robert Emynd doe by this present declare and acknowledge that the said lease
although it was taken in my name as aforesaid, yet that the same was in truth ever intended and meant unto me
the saide Robert Emynd but in trust to and for the oule use of my master Sir Robert Drury of Houghton aforesaid
knight, to be by him disposed of accordinge to his direction and to noe other pose intent or purpos **IN WITNESS**
whereof heremto f the said Robert Emynd haue sett my hande and stede the vijt and xxvijt daie of October anno
domini 1609 and in the yere of the reigne of our soverayne lord James by the yere of god 1596 of England ffrauncis
and Ireland the fift and of Scotland the one and fortyth yeare of the fauour of the kyng the kyng of England ffrauncis
