Be it known. by their presented That whereas Abramis Dodd Citizen and woodmonger
of London by his indenture of lease bearing date the two and twentieth daie of this instant month of October
for the Consideration therein mentioned did demise guarantee and to farme lett unto Robert Emynd of Hantsfleete in
the Countie of Suff. yeoman one parte or partell of grounde in Clementes Inn feildes in the pish of St. Clement
daynes in the Countie of Midd. as yt was then severed with a sufficient fence, measured and bounded out from one
other parte or partell of ground then in the occupation of the said Abramis Dodd beinge pte of the plott of grounde
wherby the said Abramis Dodd holdeth by a former lease made unto him from Sir John Holles of Houghton in the
Countie of Nottingham knight, and the Lady Ann his wife do hold unto the said Robert Emynd his executor and
assignes from the feast of Saint Michael that changed then last past before the date thereof for the terme of
thre score and one quarter of a yeare, as by the said indenture maye more at large appeare **Nowe**
knowe yet that I the said Robert Emynd doe by their presented declare and acknowledge that the said lease
although it was taken in my name as aforesaid, yet that the same was in truth ever intended and ment unto me
the said Robert Emynd but in trust to and for the onlie use of my master Sir Robert Drury of Hantsfleete aforesaid
knight, to be by him disposed of accordinge to his direction and to noe other use intent or purpose **In witness**
whereof hereunto I the said Robert Emynd have sett my hand and scale the thre and twentieth daie of October Anno
dñi 1609 and in the yeare of the raigne of our soveraigne Lord James by the grace of god Kinge of England Abramis
and Ireland the fift and of Scotland the one and fortieth defender of the faith &c. # # # # #
