people to whom these parts shall come John Turner citizen and Sheriffmynster of London studech getting **whereas** John Holles of Houghton in the County of Northampton and the Lady Anne his wife by their indenture of lease bearing date the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord god 1605. And in the year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord James by the grace of God King of England Scotland France and Ireland Defender of the faith or (that is to say) of England France and Ireland the King and of Scotland the King and Churches. For the consideration in the said indenture of lease mentioned did demise guarantee and to forms litten unto the said John Turner his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns a plot or parcel of ground to be taken and severed out of Oldmills fields in the parish of St. Olmills Church in the County of Middlesex a plot of ground lying next the Brickwall on the South side of the garden or ground now in the tenure of St. Robert Drury Knight or of his assigns or assigns and tenants in the North and South (that is to say) from the East side one hundred and twenty feet of length or thereabouts in breadth at the South end twenty eight feet of length or thereabouts and in breadth at the North end fifty feet of length or thereabouts, with free ingress egress and regress into and from the said plot or parcel of ground at all tymes during the term therein granted **To have and to hold** the said plot or parcel of ground before the said demise as it then do be severed, containing the length and breadth aforesaid together with free ingress egress and regress at aforesaid unto the said John Turner his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns from the feast of St. Michael the first day of the month of September next following after the date of the said indenture of lease until the full end and term of one and twenty years from the next next ensuing, and fully to be completed and ended **yearly and payeage** towards the said demise of one and twenty years unto the said John Holles and the Lady Anne his wife and the heirs and assigns of the said John Holles the tenth part of lawful money of England at four shillings half pence in the year (that is to say) at the feast of St. John Baptist, St. Michael the Archangel, the Birth of our Lord god, and Christmas the eighth penny thereof by open and equal portions, as in and by the said indenture of lease (wherein and contained divers other covenants granted articles and agreements) more at large is doleth and may appear **Now** know ye that the said John Turner for and in consideration of the sum of one and twenty pounds of lawful money of England to me in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these parts by Robert Emyn of Houghton in the County of Suffolk Esquire, which and whereof the said John Turner doth acknowledge and confess my self fully satisfied contented and assured and of the sum of one and twenty pounds of lawful money of England to me in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these parts by Robert Emyn Esquire his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns of whom by these parts shall be granted or bargained the assigns and the parts, and by these parts do fully and absolutely grant bargain sell assign and the parts unto the said Robert Emyn his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns. Aswell the said plot or parcel of ground and all other the premises by the said written indenture of lease demise and the said written indenture of lease and all other writings containing the same premises, as also all the right title interest possession claim demand whatsoever of the said John Turner here may, might should or ought to have or claim to have to do and in the said plot and parcel of ground and all other the premises lease and containing aforesaid **To have and to hold** the said plot and parcel of ground and all other the premises by the said indenture of lease demise with the covenants and conditions therein contained and also all the right title interest possession claim demand of me the said John Turner of me and to the same as aforesaid unto the said Robert Emyn his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns from the day of the date of these parts and forwards for during and until the full end and accomplishmentment of all the said term of one and twenty years in and by the said indenture of lease granted, to be yet to come and performed, fully to be completed and ended **And** the said John Turner for me mynne heirs Executors and Administrators and for assigns of me, do covenent promise and grant to and with the said Robert Emyn his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns and assigns of whom by these parts, that the said written indenture of lease the said plot or parcel of ground and all other the premises by the said indenture demise with the covenants, now and and so from henceforth, during the residue of the said term of one and twenty years shall continue free and absolutely acquitted and discharged of and from all former bargains sold, gift grants charges for services surrenders fines, and incumbrances whatsoever, had made committed or done by me the said John Turner or by any other person or persons whatsoever, by my self or person the said covenants and conditions contained in the said indenture of lease contained with in the last part and behalf from henceforth and to be paid done and performed for and in respect of the said plot or parcel of ground and other the premises in and by the said indenture of lease granted and by the said written indenture **Juravit** quod the said Robert Emyn the said parts had entered joyntly with his hands and Sealed upon the thirtieth day of October in the year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord James
