This byl made the daye of August in the xxij<sup>th</sup> yere of  
the regne of s<sup>r</sup> Henry Lord Kingdoun the eight mynes past  
that I Roger Carvers gent have sweryed and had the daye  
of the daye gone of nicholas Barre of London Esquier  
the son of Rich and eight pound Sterling in full and to be  
payment of and for the clere purchase of two tentis shippes  
in the Cytte of London wch was done by me in pate no 12  
yrs 3<sup>rd</sup> or late was in the p[er]c[on] of tyme of one John Gurnod  
and thid y[ea]r newly went of my m[ar]id, And therer lyff in the p[er]c[on]  
of saynt Elens and y[ea]r or late was in the tyme of one John Cawley  
and it is by the newly went of my h[us]b[an]d wch payed two tentis shippes  
and he sayd Roger Carver wch do greate by his spende to affirme  
by sayd my selfe was payed on þ[er] purþe al þ[er] halfe yere or  
apoynte before the feast of saynt mayn wch was next  
after the daye gone of my h[us]b[an]d bynde me myne payred  
þereturh and affirme by þese þre þre þre þre In witness whereof  
I have subþryued this byl wch my hand and set my seal  
þe daye and yere first abovewritten
