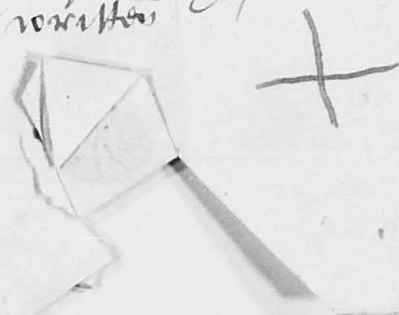

This be made the xxth day of November in the fourth
 year of our sovereign lord that now is King Edward the
 sixth by the grace of god son with us that
 John Hall knight to my lord marquis' court have
 received and paid the day of making James of Morda
 Baron esquire the sum of twenty shillings of lawfull
 money, of which he the said James Morda
 sent for one years' farm of a stable in the
 Castle in Holburne ended us my lord's last part
 for wages and some of xxth of November my self
 fullie satisfied and paid and thereof do hereby
 acquit and discharge the said Morda his heirs
 assigns and assigns by these presents in witness
 whereof I to this be of same part my self the
 day and year first above written
