 ran declare unto yo^r L. I beseech yo^r L. to accept
 that my offer in good part beinge sovereyn that
 myn habilitie is not answerable to the desire
 I have to dole more liberalllye with him herein
 And thus in remembrance of myn humble Dutie
 unto yo^r good L. I take my leave from
 Worcester this 15th daye of Januarye 1566.
