 that were sufficient, but if no body follows the matter
 it will be good for yo^r nor for me
 it would be notified (if it be not done already) to
 the land is to be taken, and therefore those that are
 to deal w^{ch} it are to come and serve in what
 part they will take it, and what they will give
 for drable what for pasture what for meadows
 it would be entered into writing, and that
 writing, because it is a matter of weight
