the m^{ch}. that he is to paye, and will call upon the receipt
of the same according to our last agrement.

I doubt not but y^e have kept y^e daye wth Edward for the receiving
of my wrightinge according to y^e comys.

After I receyve answer from L^{ie} for the R^{ey}, of
Burrowghes I will not fayle to returne answer to my
L^{ie} modestly contynnyng that matter, And y^e knowe
that the fault is not myne that it hath not bene done
alredie.

As touching Rogge, I h^{is} well that he is some of my m^{ch}
to be payd for a fyne according to the L^{ie} of y^e L^{ie}.
and for the supplye of cowart to be answered for redgarde
anowte to the L^{ie} of the same L^{ie}. I am contented he
shall have a lease out of my lease for y^e yeres so
as end yere be attached to my self and the origynall
lease to remaine wth me according as y^e wright.
