

Whereas the offices of Clerkship or Register and Submarshall for the Admiralty within the counties of Dorset and Suffe. with the profits of the same be upon the death of Anthony Stile holder the late exerciser of the said offices lawfully vested in Anthony Stile the younger. some of the foresaid Anthony the elder. And by severall grante. and patente thercof made by me may at large appeare. I have therefore thought good to requyre you to suffer the said Anthony Stile the younger quietly and peaceably to use and exercise the said offices ord. hath byn. accustomed. without any your contradiction or impediment. And that from henceforth you accept and take him for lawfull clerk. or Register and Submarshall in the counties aforesaid according to the severall tenors of the patente made in this behalf. And so fare you well, From the Court at Greenwich this 22th of Aprile 1583.
