



S^r so soone as occasion is offered, & shall not fayle (god willing,) to see p[er]formed, as carefullly as I can, the effecte of yo^r letter delinereed to me, bnt in the meane tyme I am to adverstise you, that this present day y^e fourteene of october, theare cam m^r Thomas Crofte, who kepereth at st. williams heydons, Robt Fennis gent, & Robt Hind, yeman, s^r williams men, wth Richard Law^s some ^{clerk} parson of Laneriset, & James Leman Laborer of houst market, wth two others, whose names as yet I can not learene but by his instrument was a mesurer of ground, theas men mesured one pease of ground on thornage heath btteling on y^e north pt. to Laneriset, and is y^e pease wher they haue vsed vsuypingly to com, & also an other part of thornage heath toward the east, wth two peases of copyy shold lond my tenner & occupation of Henry Bac^c of thornage afore ^{holder of this maner} sayd theare vnto adioyning, wth out y^e primitie eyther of you, my sa, or y^e tenant, lying farre distante from y^e pease of y^e north part, as also from all y^e lond, or liberty of sheapes confe, of the sayd s^r willm, Even as they wear fising this last p[er]yll cam John Knighte my sa servant, who asked them what they ded measuring, theare, to whom y^e strang^r whom he know not, answered for no ha[n]de wth liche a fonda man he was satisfied wth, & so they all depted. What may be done in this case I besheeche yo^r w^{ch} consider wth yo^r comfett, & this vntemperate dealing of him, & his, may be so qualfied, as my sa may enioy his living.
