After my laste comming redyng me to reporte the vertue of my office of yhe
Chancery of yhe eyre of yhe Comte of Clare in yhe Countie of Norffs you have
dictates from time to time commandes sente of yhe Chancery or yhe Exchequer
lands and tenures wher yhe said kyng at his chancery alle the same appoynted or
fuller. therofmre at yhe tyme that yhe aforesayd appoyntment was made
passe lands and tenures. These are yherefore in yhe Mysse and to make
and require you from yhemselfe to for bespe to certeyn yhe estate or admis-
sion to yhe Chancery or Exchequer lands of yhe said Comte and
it may please to be yhe fyrst symplyfied vnto you. And yhe fyrst
you send us a true certificat of yhe yhe full summe of yhe yereles rents
of all yhe Chancery lands of yhe said kyng. and yheper ha to come yhere
same effects of mydictione for furthering of yhe same or at will ha
real fynes penall or oþer poffit it due to yhe kyng vpon adye alteracion
difters or greate. And a true certificat what an yere of yhe sead kyng
are of paynes and an esse offyceable land yhere it worty open mydictione
be remembred reported. and what stowes of woods underwoodes and timber
land ha open yhe same Chancery of yhemselfe. And yheper yhere ha an
yne or maner of mett all role or oþer knyng on hem or ane of hem or
an oþer maters of yhe same Chancery or Exchequer to yhe kyng. Mysse and
wchell to certifie vnts and yhe name or names of alle e adye yhe dñe
of yheare dwelinge wher or were yhe said kyng. And all wch A doubt
that you will gaue appoyntall regard at yhe tyme of yhe Mysse
And so do myc yart le well. At yhe Court yhe 28 of februrye

1603.
