borth of ouir oowne subiecte and of other purt being pleschlyng good leuge and truthe etc to. Edith comynche chesire to passe by reason therof perte the tyme also to be of other nacione therat thame of a nombre
of disordered psone deselling towne or neare the harden Creeke or landynge place of this ouir realme and other ouir dominions certeynly lefched therof vnto the same fyndynge therof ymportaunce and other necessarie and tyme of theyr sayng by bringynge
buyng and exchangynge therof thereto at the same tyme contempste of us and ouir lades to the grete clamour of this ouir realme. Lere us for the dyscrecyng of our dñe to sende god e the
soulde we haue alredy used good meane to finding gylt condenmente not yet remedie to the same. Is he rewe haue thoughte of come liche betis meane to do we doubt not but shal levere the same fullie The liche therof
we truste other purt ouir neigboris will for us pte upon ouir example to done vpon thame tyme And therefore for the best pformynge whereof and for the executioun of the same conteyned of you Edith comynche and fydeler
we haue chosen and appoynted you to haue the yere capte vnde us to gyde that we liche enormetys be geyste used in the harden Creeke and landynge place therin that ouir Comynche of D. in tyme worte and ordene by us
articles of capitulacion to chaff from tyme to tyme be sent unto you signyd by six of ouir purde Comynche. And to that end ouir pleasure and commandement as afer you shall have diligentely pored and considered the said articles
that you shal those and appoynt by vertue and authorite hereof to your Deputy for the executioun of the same arthe and comany honeste serete and justic psone deselling towne or neare any of theys harden Creekes and w
landynge places wherin that chese to you shal think necessarie for that pose. Having a penall regarde that they nor any of them arthe in respecte of any Office or otherwise by pffession in maner of lyding or in any other worte
likely for hope of gylte feme of discodeng of thei oowne forme ympeachment or other pccable pfecte or intent to fforc any purte or other offendore infirmyng them selfes in rayng of thame ente of ouir realme being paled
out wry honeste diligentely and chefullie attente from tyme to tyme the executioun of theys articles. And for the better executioun hereof we will that you shal give to them an ordene to executre thesame chage fulle And that
cypre comynche nome be appoynted to be your Deputy in this behalfe to we ouer one of theys harden Creekes or landynge place be lefte vpponedes of sufficient psone to take thereto and lode theremto in liche worte the ryghte w
Edith psone or any of them it shalbe ladefull for you to remode and appoynt other theri placed at often as you shal, vntion or chaff as it shalbe. And for that pose you shal mynd togethe or the more parte of you
attording to the comoditey of you deselling onto any maner at the leaste or ofteyn spesial to the said harden Creeke and landynge place as vnderstante by the besy meane you may holde you and Deputy shal haue
pfermed the chaffe commited unto them to thende that by your assistance ouir intenton may be the beter fydedy. And thamondeire that you shal finde may be fydedy. And thamondeire that you shal
desy ouir purde Comynche attording vpon ouir psone as you haue appoynted yo Deputy to who thereto and howe ther chage shal be distributed. And afer that in like maner to solle yo preudge vnto any maner at the
leaste and for the furthes and more spedew executioun of this ouir purpos we do authorize you to do or to you shal leve it uedfull in any parte of that chese new the sea coste to make your pprete to the
chaff pleschly to impannel the iugement for rayng onto the tyme in the pmissed and at condement tyme a place to enquier by the wry of xi good and ladefull men of the said Comynche of sixtyn pnynges in demembre and other
matere as the conteyned in the said articles to you shal from tyme to tyme pcedre signyd by six of ouir purde Comynche And see so and comynche the maner of cheffy wryng. Oyliffe custome Compasseys
Cypre Oyliffe Captaynes of Castelle Gates arte and all other ouir offyceis ministeris and subiecte whiche ther be in thame assyng and obedient vnto you in executioun of this ouir Commission as becometh them. In
