 the Hon^d the Governor and Company of the Colony of
 Connecticut in New England in the full and just sum
 of Two Thousand Pounds Lawfull money of the said
 Colony to the which payment well and truly to be
 made to the said Governor and Company we the
 said Robert Durkee and
 do Bind our selves our Heirs Executors and Admin^{rs}
 jointly and Severally firmly by these Presents
 Sealed with our Seals Dated in Hartford this 27th Day
 of January 1763

The Condition of the above Obligation is Such that
 whereas the above named Robert Durkee is and has
 acted as Paymaster to a certain Foot Company raised
 and Intended by Cap^t Giles Scott for his Majesty's Service
 and in the Pay of this Colony the Campaign 1762
 now if the said Robert Durkee shall faithfully and
 seasonably pay and discharge to the several officers and
 Soldiers of said Company their respective Dues and as
 he shall receive orders from y^e Pay Table only Treasurer
 thereof then the above Obligation shall be void and else
 shall remain and be in full force power & Virtue
 Signed Sealed & Dd
