

Know all Men by these Presents that we Robert Durkee  
of Windham and Israel Putnam of Pomfret both  
in County of Windham  
are Holden and firmly do stand bound and Obliged to  
the Hon<sup>t</sup> the Governor and Company of the Colony of  
Connecticut in New England in the full and payment  
of Two Thousand Pounds Lawfull money of the said  
Colony to the which payment well and truly to be  
made to the said Governor and Company we the  
said Robert Durkee and  
do Bind our Selves our Heirs Executors and Administrators  
joyntly and severally firmly by these Presents  
Sealed without Seal Dated in Hartford this 27<sup>th</sup> Day  
of January 1763

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that  
whereas the above named Robert Durkee is and has  
acted as Paymaster to a certain Lost Company raised  
and enlisted by Capt<sup>t</sup> Giles Elliott for his Majestys service  
and in the Pay of this Colony the Campaign 1762  
now is the said Robert Durkee shall faithfully and  
severably pay and discharge to the several officers and  
soldiers of said Company their respective dues and  
he shall receive orders from yr Pay Table only so far  
therefor then the above Obligation shall be void and else  
shall remain and be in full force power & Virtue
