In Error - Assignment of Errors. —

James Sterling

And upon this the asf. Joseph Haight
by Richard Stockton his Attorney comes & says
that in the Record & process & also in the Rendition of
the Judgment asf. it has manifestly erred in this, to
wit, that it appears that the Judgment asf. in favor
asf. rendered was rendered for the s. James against the
said Joseph when by the laws of this State Judgment
ought to have been rendered for the s. Joseph against the
s. James therefore in this there is manifest Error. And
the asf. Joseph further saith at the Trial of the s. Cause
before the Judges of the s. Inferior Court of common pleas

Evidence to the Jury — but the Judges of the Court asf. then & there
admitted the Testimony & then & there charged the Jury that
the Evidence so as asf. offered was legal & admissible Evidence
& accordingly it was then & there admitted by the Court & read
in Evidence to the Jury whereupon the Counsel for the s.
Joseph the Exception asf. in a certain Bill then & there did
record & Robert L. Hooper Esq. one of the Judges of the s.
Court his Seal to the s. Bill did then & there put according

to the form of the statute in such case made & provided -
And the ^r. Joseph brings here into Court the Writ of
Exceptions as^d. with the seal of the ^r. Robert L. Hooper
one of the Judges as^d. put - And the ^r. Joseph prays
the Writ of the State to the as^d. Rob^t. L. Hooper Esq^r. to be di-
rected to command him to appear before the Justices of
the Supreme Court at Trenton to confess or deny his
Seal as^d. and to him it is granted &c. Wherefore the
^r. Joseph by his attorney as^d. prays that the judg-
ment as^d. in form as^d. rendered for the errors as^d.
& for others which may be in the Record & process as^d.
may be reversed annulled & for nought holden &c.
