

Worcester. H. To the Sberiff or Marshall of the said County of Worcester - or either  
of their Deputies, or Constables of the Town of Lancaster - within  
the said County, or to any or either of them, Greeting.

IN His Majesty's Name, you are required to Attach the Goods or Estate of  
Ephraim Willard of Lancaster in y<sup>e</sup> County of Worcester husbandman  
to the Value of Fifty Shillings, and for want thereof to take  
the Body of the said Ephraim Willard - (if he may be found  
in your Precinct) and him safely keep, so that he may be had before me  
Asenias Ward - Esq; one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace for  
the County aforesaid, at my Dwelling-House in Shrewsbury on monday  
the twenty seventh Day of July Instant - at nine - of the Clock in the  
fore noon; then and there to answer to Jotham Bush of Shrewsbury  
Esq; County of Worcester Gentleman in a plea of y<sup>e</sup> Case. For  
that whereas y<sup>e</sup> said Ephraim Willard at Shrewsbury aforesaid on y<sup>e</sup>  
Seventh day of April one thousand seven hundred & Sixty six by his  
note under his hand for Value hee promised to pay unto y<sup>e</sup> said  
Jotham Bush or order one pound ten Shillings on demand with  
lawful Interest for y<sup>e</sup> same till paid; but has not done it though  
often requested.

To the Damage of the said Jotham Bush as he saith - the Sum of  
Forty Shillings, as shall then and there be made to appear, with other  
due Damages. Hereof fail not, and make due Return of this Writ, and of your  
Doings therein, unto myself, at or before the said twenty seventh - Day of  
July - Dated at Shrewsbury aforesaid, the fiftenth - Day of  
July - in the Seventh Year of His Majesty's Reign. Annoque Domini, 1767
