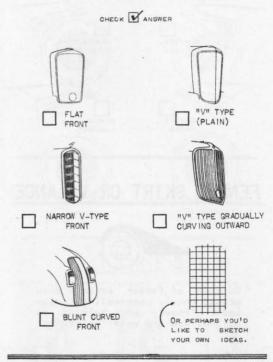

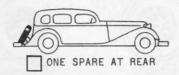

# BRAKE LINKAGE

There are two methods of transmitting braking effort from the pedal to the brake shoes at the wheels:

"MECHANICAL"

Steel cables or rods are used to connect the foot pedal with brakes on the wheels.

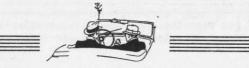
"HYDRAULIC"

Braking effort transmitted through cylinders and pipes containing fluid instead of through mechanical linkage.

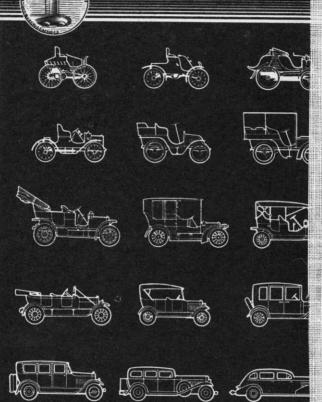
