## OFFICIAL GALLERY TOURS AND GUIDE SERVICE

The Exhibition of Paintings and Sculpture for 1934 is to be seen in the Art Institute from June 1 to November 1. The exhibition stresses the development of American painting and also contains significant works of Old and Modern Masters from both European and American collections. Many of the paintings have belonged to the great foreign museums.

The exhibition is of such importance and scope that many visitors will wish to see it under guidance. Accordingly, the Art Institute offers the following tours and guide service:

A GENERAL TOUR through the galleries of the special exhibition of paintings and sculpture every week day at 9:30 A. M., and on Sundays at 1 P. M.

A LECTURE in the galleries on a selected section of the exhibition every week day at 11:00 A. M. The subjects for the week will be announced on the bulletin board in the main lobby.

THE FEE for all gallery tours is TWENTY-FIVE CENTS per person.

PRIVATE GUIDE SERVICE preferably by appointment in advance. One dollar per hour for two persons or less, additional persons fifty cents apiece. For groups of ten or more the charge is twenty-five cents per person.

PRIVATE GROUPS may be formed upon request, for more detailed study of the collections.

MISS HELEN PARKER, Head of the Department of Museum Instruction, is in charge of all official gallery tours. She will be assisted by MISS HELEN BARSALOUX.
