Soon the girls asked us to buy another drink and we were served with 3 bottles of Topaz Beer and 1 glass of grape juice for which I Mr. X- payed 65¢ plus a 15¢ tip to Dave.

I heard Lillian solicit Mr. X- to prostitution for the sum of 3⁰⁰ and May solicited me to prostitution for the sum of 2⁰⁰ plus 1⁰⁰ for a room. May insisted on us going to the La Plante Hotel and before we left May virtually begged me to buy 1/2 pint of Bowdon Whiskey. She then ordered the whiskey and I payed 65¢ plus a 10¢ tip to Dave for same.

We then left for the La Plante Hotel.

Amiel then ushered May and myself into room 21 - (front room east) and ushered Lillian into room 23 (1st room south of room 21 both rooms on 2nd floor. Inv. X and myself immediately left the rooms and in the hall Inv. X gave Lillian \$1.00 for her trouble.

We left May in room 21 sitting on the bed after she had solicited me to prostitution for \$2.00 and I also heard Lillian solicit Inv. X to prostitution for \$3.00 while in the hall.

We three then left for the Columbia Cafe.
