




Address delivered at the dedication of the
cemetery at Gettysburg.

Four score and seven years ago our fathers
brought forth on this continent, a new na-
tion, conceived in Liberty, and dedicated
to the proposition that all men are cre-
ated equal.

Now we are engaged in a great civil war,
testing whether that nation, or any nation
so conceived and so dedicated, can long
endure. We are met on a great battle-field
of that war. We have come to dedicate a
portion of that field, as a final resting
place for those who here gave their lives,
that that nation might live. It is alto-
gether fitting and proper that we should
do this.

But, in a larger sense, we can not dedi-
cate— we can not consecrate— we can not
hallow this ground. The brave men, liv-
ing and dead, who struggled here, have con-
secrated it, far above our poor power to add


or detract. The world will little note, nor
long remember what we say here, but it can
never forget what they did here. It is for us
the living, rather, to be dedicated here to
the unfinished work which they who fol-
lowed here have thus far so nobly advanced.
It is rather for us to be here dedicated to
the great task remaining before us—that
from these honored dead we take increased
devotion to that cause for which they gave
the last full measure of devotion—that
we here highly resolve that these dead shall
not have died in vain—that this nation,
under God, shall have a new birth of free-
dom—and that government of the people,
by the people, for the people, shall not per-
ish from the earth.



Centennial Memorials.

IN CONGRESS, JULY 4, 1776.

The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America.

When in the course of human events it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to this separation. We hold these truths to be self-evident; that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights; that among these are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness. That to secure these rights Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed. — That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all experience hath shewn, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security. — Such has been the patient sufferance of these colonies; and such is now the necessity which constitutes you to alter their former Systems of Government. The history of the present King of Great Britain is a history of repeated injuries and usurpations, all having in direct object the establishment of an absolute Tyranny over these States. To prove this let Facts be submitted to a candid world. — He has refused his Assent to Laws, the most wholesome and necessary for the public good. — He has faltered his Governors to pass Laws of immediate and pressing importance, and hath suspended their operation till his Assent should be obtained; and when suspended, he has utterly neglected to attend to them. — He has refused to pass other Laws for the accommodation of large districts of people, and those people would negotiate the rights of Representation in the Legislature, a right insipable to them, and formidable? to grants only. — He has called together legislative bodies at places unusual, uncomon, and distant from the Depository of our Public Records, for the sole purpose of fatiguing them into compliance with his measures. — He has dissolved Representative Houses repeatedly, exposing with many forms his invasions on the rights of the people. — He has refused for along time, after such dissolutions, to cause others to be elected; whereby the Legislative houses, incapable of Convocation, have returned to the People at large for their service, the stateman in the mean time exposed to all the dangers of invasion from without, and convolution within. — He has endeavored to prevent the population of these States, for that purpose obstructing the Law for Naturalization of Foreigners; refusing his Assent to laws for encouraging their migration hither, and raising their conditions of new Appropriations of Lands. — He has obstructed the Administration of Justice, by refusing his Assent to laws for establishing Judiciary Powers. — He has made Judges dependent on his Will alone for the tenure of their offices, and the amount and payment of their salaries. — He has created a multitude of New Offices, and sent other persons of his choice to have over our people, and cut off their Justices. — He has kept among us in times of peace Standing Armies without the consent of our legislatures. — He has granted Letters of Marque and Reprisal to Captains of Armed Vessels, authorizing them an Usurpary government and enlarging their Boundaries so as to render their actions unanswerable and fit instruments for introducing Hesame absolute despotism into Colonies. — He has taken every rule, charter, abolishing our most valuable Laws, and striking fundamentally the basis of our governments. — For suspending our own Legislation, and declaring themselves invested with power to legislate for us in all cases whatsoever. — He has abdicated Government here, by declining us out of his Protection and waging War against us. — He has plundered us seas, ravaged our coasts, burnt our towns, and destroyed the lives of our people. — He is at this time transporting large Armies of foreign Mercenaries to combat the Friends of Death, desolation and tyranny, already begun, with circumstances of cruelty & perfidy scarcely paralleled in the most barbarous ages, and totally unworthy the Head of a civilized nation. — He has constituted our烽狼狼烟, already begun, with circumstances of cruelty & perfidy scarcely paralleled in the most barbarous ages, and totally unworthy the Head of a civilized nation. — He has constituted our烽狼狼烟, already begun, with circumstances of cruelty & perfidy scarcely paralleled in the most barbarous ages, and totally unworthy the Head of a civilized nation. — He has excited domestic insurrections amongst us, and has endeavored to bring on the inhabitants of our hostile, the merciful Indian savages, whose known rule of warfare, is an unmerciful desecration of all age, sex and condition. — In every place where Oppression & Tyranny have Ruled in the most horrid manner, our unpaid Rioters have been armed with equal injury. A Rioter whose character is thus marked by every act which may deprive a Tyrant is unfit to be the ruler of a free people. — Nor have we been wanting in attention to our British brethren. We have warned them from time to time of attempts by their legislature to extend an unnatural jurisdiction over us. We have reminded them of the circumstances of our emigration and settlement here. We have appealed to their native justice and magnanimity, and we have conjured them by the ties of our common kindred to disavow their usurpations, which, would inevitably irritate our connivance and correspondence. They too have been deaf to the voice of justice and of humanity. — We must, therefore, acquiesce in the necessity, which denounces our separation, and hold them, as we hold the rest of mankind, Enemies in War, in Peace Friends.

We, therefore, the Representatives of the United States of America, in General Congress, Assembled, appealing to the Supreme Judge of the world for the rectitude of our intentions, do, in the Name and by Authority of the good People of these colonies, solemnly publish and declare, That these United Colonies are and of Right ought to be Free and Independent States; that they are Absolved from all Allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connection between them and the State of Great Britain, is and ought to be totally dissolved; and that as Free and Independent States, they have full Power to levy War, conclude Peace, contract Alliances, establish Commerce, and to do all other Acts and Things which Independent States may of right do. And for the support of this Declaration, with a firm reliance on the protection of divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives and our sacred Honor.
