## 1972 ADDENDUM

### PRELIMINARY INVENTORY

#### INTRODUCTION

The 1972 addendum to the Federation of American Scientists Papers was deposited in the addendum is of essentially the same type as in the earlier portion of the F.A.S. Papers; that is, records of and correspondence pertinent to the administrative business of the organization. The 1972 addendum both fills some of the chronological gaps in the earlier collection and brings most portions of the files more nearly up-to-date. In general, the addendum makes it possible to follow the chronology of F.A.S. activities in most areas through the late 1960's.

Users should be aware that the current inventory of the 1972 addendum is only preliminary. That is, no effort has been made to combine the addendum with the earlier collection to produce a clearly-arranged whole. Although gaps in the earlier material can in many cases be filled with material in the later, this is not immediately apparent in the physical arrangement of the papers, and users interested in subject which span the time periods of both sections should make careful cross references between the two lists. Moreover, there has been little attempt to improve on the organization of the collection as it arrived from F.A.S. Folders were grouped together by categories, but no changes were made in the arrangement of the contents of the folders themselves, or, with only a few exceptions, in folder labels. Any confusion which might result from roughness of the current inventory can be eliminated, for the Subject Files, 1945-1965, by the excellent file organization devised by the F.A.S. staff -- an organization system which has been left unaltered in this inventory. The Subject Files, 1966-70 and the Administrative Files, 1960-69, however, were not part of this system, and users should be wary of relying too heavily on the somewhat superficial information presented in this preliminary inventory. Finally, the inventory is preliminary in that, apart from elimination of the more obvious duplicate papers (mainly printed matter), all of the papers received from the F.A.S. have been retained. Thus there are documents in parts of the files (particularly in the Financial Affairs section of the Administrative Files, 1960-69) which will certainly be of little use for most kinds of research.

It should be apparent, then, that as soon as time can be found, a complete re-assessment and re-organization of the F.A.S. Papers should be undertaken, and the various portions of the collections worked into a rational whole. Until then, the present inventory should enable the user to approach the collection, but he should approach it aware of the limitations of his guide.

## PRELIMINARY INVENTORY

The 1972 addition to the F.A.S. Papers is divided into the following three sections: Subject Files, 1945-65; Subject Files, 1966-70; and Administrative Files, 1960-69.

### Subject Files, 1945-65

This material is arranged according to the file-reorganization system devised in 1966 by the F.A.S. staff. No alterations were made either in order of filing or in folder labels. The five-volume typescript "Index to F.A.S. Files" (Index Box, before Box 1), prepared by the F.A.S. staff, should serve as a guide to this material. When used in conjunction with the folder list below, volumes I-III of the "Index" will indicate the location of particular documents. Volumes IV and V contain an alphabetically arranged subject index.

No comprehensive attempt was made to verify the F.A.S. list with the contents of the folders themselves. A cursory spot-check, however, seemed to indicate that very few items are missing. (Known exceptions include several documents belonging in folder 23264, as well as entire folders 32013-23, 33001, 33008, and 33011.) When material is pertinent to more than one subject category, however, the F.A.S. staff seems usually to have filed copies of the other items within each of the relevant categories. If a user has difficulty with apparently missing documents, therefore, he may be able to solve his problem by skimming the subject index and cross-checking related categories.

N.B. The last six folders in Box 43 were apparently inadvertently omitted from the F.A.S. staff's numbering of subject folders. They do belong in this section but are not listed in the F.A.S. "Index." See list for Box 43, below, for their contents.

#### Subject Files, 1966-70

The material in this section is of essentially the same type as the material in the previous section, and follows it chronologically. (In a few cases, however, pre-1966 documents not included in the F.A.S. staff's file reorganization project have been included here.) Folders have been grouped under general subject headings, alphabetically arranged. The single exception to this alphabetical arrangement is publications (both by F.A.S. and received by F.A.S.), grouped together at the end of the subject file. Within subject categories, occasional changes were made in folder labels to increase clarity. The contents and the arrangement of documents within each folder, however, have been left as they were received from F.A.S.

Because this material was not part of the F.A.S. staff file reorganization project, there is no subject index. The list which follows itemizes only subject headings and folder labels, not individual documents as in the F.A.S. staff-prepared list.

## Administrative Files, 1960-69

Files in this section include all material relevant OT F.A.S. administration: executive and council business, financial and membership records, administrative correspondence, and the like.
