

In the name of God Amen: I, Eulalia
Whitlock of the City of Hartford, State of
Connecticut, Widow, being of sound mind
and memory, do make, publish, and declare
this my last will and testament, in manner
and form following, that is to say:

First I direct my executors herein after named,
to pay and discharge my funeral expenses,
and should there be any outstanding debts
at my decease, (there being none now) to
pay the same as soon as practicable.

Secondly I give, bequeath, and devise to my
sister, Elizabeth Williams, the usufruct and pro-
duct of all my estate both real and personal,
the profits, product and interest from the same
to be used and enjoyed by her during the
term of her natural life; and from and
immediately after her decease, I give, devise
and bequeath the said estate, real and
personal absolutely to my surviving children,
Henrietta M. Carter, John C. Whitlock,
the children of my deceased daughter
Mary C. Johnson, and the son of my
deceased daughter, Caroline E. Seymour,
to them and their heirs forever, to be equally
divided in four parts, and each to have
share and share alike as follows - that is
to say: one share to each of my surviving
children, Henrietta M. Carter, and John C.
Whitlock, one share to the children of my
deceased daughter Mary C. Johnson, and one
share to the son, William J. Seymour of
my deceased daughter Caroline E. Seymour
and to their heirs forever.

It is my wish that my said estate should be divided and partitioned as before divided among my heirs as soon as practicable after my decease, and should my Executors deem it advisable, for the benefit of each of my heirs as may be mining, to invest for the same that may fall to their share, they are authorized to do the same according to their judgment and discretion.

Lastly I do hereby name, constitute and appoint Henry W. Carter & Isaac F. Segerson my Executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all and every other will by me heretofore made.
