I have this day received of H. Wendell Carter, an Order on the Alabama Cotton Prep for One Hundred & seventy five Bales Cotton, to be shipped to Singapore in an A.I. British Ship, and to be consigned to Messrs John K. Gilliat & Co on account of said H. Wendell Carter, and on which I agree to advance all the charges on said Cotton accruing in New Orleans, viz River Freight Cotton prep Charges, City & Fire Insurance &c, the said to be held in Singapore for 80 per pound, unless there is a prospect of a higher price being obtained, or unless ordered to be sold sooner, the proceeds of said Cotton to be subject to the Order of said H. Wendell Carter

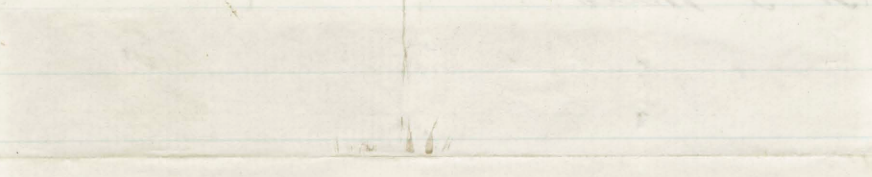
