with much pleasure that I
embrace the opportunity of
again addressing you. I
have been absent in Texas
for over two years & have
just returned. I have
with me now about fifteen
Negroes, who say they will
stay with me next year.
If they do I think that I
can make it profitable, if
farming can be made so at
all under the present system.
For I shall give it a fair
trial so far as regards close
attention & industry. I have
sufficient team for fifteen
hands, & meat enough to last

me & money enough to buy corn
enough to last me until
about the first of March
or April - after that I will
have to call on you or the
Bour will sink - I shall
plant for a hundred bales &
I feel every confidence in
making that much if I
can make any arrange-
ment with the Breg so that
will bind him - That is com-
pel him to stay with me
the year out -

Enclosed you will
find a list of Notes that I
left with you in the Spring
of 1861. Which you had
better send up to me by Mr
Lovelace - who will hand
you this - in order that I
may get them renewed -
The most of them will be

good at some future day.
I also send you a list of
the names of the parties that I
traded land to in the Spring
of '62 for notes they held
against me - Mr. J. A. Ma-
ckinder of your house
will recollect that I gave
the parties a title to the land
but before they would deliver
up the notes they required
that I should send them
my Wifes renunciation of
her title - Not being able to
come down myself I sent
it to you with instructions
to get the notes & send them
up to me, but the City was
taken before this was accom-
plished, & thus the matter
stands yet - I am very anxious
that this matter should be
attended to, for the other
