The following is a description of Carrs Land in Union Parish - Known as Cherry Ridge"

It is considered one of the best of not the very best plantations in Union Parish - The improvements consist among other things of a large fine dwelling, with necessary out buildings, fine stables and abundant Cabin Room for hands, There is about 500 acres of good Land, There is a good Store House, on the Land - and a nice Church, and Masonic Lodge, and is in the midst of a nice healthy neighborhood, a certain Cotton Plantation known as Cherry Ridge containing nine hundred & forty two acres ^{5/16} and composed of the following divisions to wit,

North West Quarter Section - & West Half of South West Quarter Section
Now, - East Half Section & East Half of South West Quarter Section & East Half of North West Quarter (Except 50 acres off the North End of this last subdivision) of Section no. 410,
East Half of North East Quarter Section no 8. & the North West Quarter Section & West Half of North East Quarter Section no 9 in Township no twenty two, north of Range One West, and also following Tract, lying all & near the Bayou L'Anse & belonging to ~~Cherry~~ to Cherry Ridge & described as the West Half of the West Half Section - East Half of the North East Quarter of South West Quarter & North Half of South East Quarter Section 33,
