I have the honor to make application to be ordered temporarily to duty in the vicinity of Philadelphia & to enclose a communication from Major General Meade approving & recommending the assignment.

I wish to state that while I am not unable to proceed to any point by the usual modes of travel yet in the field my lameness & inability to mount a horse & the effect of exposure would prevent me from being of much service. By undergoing another operation recommended by the Surgeon who has attended me from the beginning I hope to recover entirely the use of my foot.

Gen Cadwallader Comdg Dep't. states to me that he needs a General Officer to replace one lately relieved from a Military Commission.
