

Bes Thorpe (Norfolk.)

(1642)

Deed dated 13 September 18th Charles 1st. relating to property

in Bes Thorpe (Norfolk.), being a settlement of pasture land

by Samuel Newson "to the use & behoofe" of his wife Margaret.

Margaret Newson had been married twice. Her first husband is

given in this deed as "Thomas Lyncolne, deceased," & he is

described as having lived at Barnham Broome, Norfolk.

Four children are mentioned as by this first marriage: — a son Isacke

Lyncolne & three daughters Margaret Lyncolne, Alice Lyncolne & Lydia

Lyncolne.
