My dear Dr. Mathews:

The answer of Rochester to the questionnaire of the Committee on Denominational Schools was adopted yesterday and I am sending to you a copy of it. I may say that after long discussion it was adopted without a dissenting vote, although there were several of the trustees who feel that the Committee, in its inclusion of Question Three, had gone beyond the scope of the resolutions of the Northern Baptist Convention creating it. Our reply was adopted with the understanding, based upon what we deemed reliable information, that the Committee is really trying to do its work in the spirit of justice and without undue prejudice. That being true, we would want to go "the second mile". Moreover, it seemed to us that a reply which would decline to answer Question Three would be liable to misinterpretation and would be unfair to the spirit and the teaching of Rochester. I would be glad to see a copy of the reply from the Chicago Divinity School, if it has been made, and I presume it has.

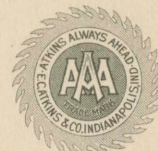




