THE New University of Chicago quietly entered on its career Saturday, October 1, without my formal opening ceremonies. Five hundred students were enrolled the first day, and it is expected that the number will be doubled within a fortnight. With the exception of the new surroundings and the noise of the workmen in the buildings adjoining tho first completed structure, it seemed as though educational work was being resumed rather than begun. President Harper succeeded in carrying out his plan, which was to "launch the craft of learning as though it had been sailing in the tide of education for the last twenty years."
