Know all men by these
Presents, that I Gideon Evans of the
District of Barnwell and State afore-
said, in consideration of the natural
love and affection which I have and bear
unto the children hereinafter named of
my deceased daughter Martha E
formerly the wife of Milledge T. Holly
of the District and State aforesaid - and
also in consideration of the sum of One
Dollar to me paid by the said Mil-
ledge T. Holly (the receipt whereof I do
hereby acknowledge) have bargained
sold, assigned and transferred and
by these presents do bargain, sell, as-
sign and transfer unto the said Mil-
ledge T. Holly a Negro Slave named
Simakky about sixteen years of age
and her child named Ginny about
two years of age - To Have and
to hold the said Slaves with their
future issue and increases unto
the said Milledge T. Holly his Ex-
ecutors, administrators and assigns
in Trust to and for the use benefit
and behoof of Mary E. Holly, Sovereign
E. Holly and Mann Hammond Holly
the minor children of the said Mil-
ledge T. Holly by my said daughter
Martha E now deceased, formerly
the

The wife of Lavin Millenage T. Holly
as aforementioned, in Equal share
and proportions - as Tenants in Com-
mon - and that upon the said chil-
dren severally attaining the age
of Twenty one year he or she shall
be entitled to receive his or her Equal
share of the said Slaves and their
future issue and increase - and
also upon this further Trust that
of any of the said Children Mary
Governor and Thann Hammond
shall die leaving no issue living at
his or her death, the share of such
deceased child shall be held
for the exclusive benefit and behoof
of the survivors or survivor of the
said Children and if all of the
said Children Mary E. Holly, Gov-
ernor E. Holly and Thann Hammond
should die leaving no issue living
at their deaths, then the said Slaves
and their future issue and increase
shall belong to my heirs and be
distributable as a portion of the
Residue of my Estate. Provided
always nevertheless that if any
of the said Children Mary E. Holly
Governor E. Holly and Thann Hammond
shall at any time die leaving
issue living at his or her death
such issue shall in all cases

represent the deceased Parent and
take the share which the said Pa-
rent, if living, would be entitled
to take - and that the
said Milledge T. Holly Trustee
or assignee, shall be and he is
legally authorized and empowered
to sell and dispose of the said share
and then future issue and increase
or any part thereof whenever said
sale may be deemed expedient
either for change of investment
or to effect a division of the property
and that the proceeds of such sale
or sales be invested in other property
real or personal which substituted
property shall be held by the said
Trustee subject to the same trusts
as are herein expressed and de-
clared of or concerning the property
now conveyed by these Presents -

the Twelfth day of July in the year
of our Lord one thousand, Eight hundred
and fifty one -
