Amy Coubli his heirs & assigns, from  
Me & my heirs & from the lawful claim  
or Claims of all persons whatsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the  
Same, & to be sound & healthy free  
from any bodily or Mental infirmity  
whatsoever. In witness whereof I  
have hereunto set my hand & seal  
at Cincinnati the 7<sup>th</sup> day of November

1834
