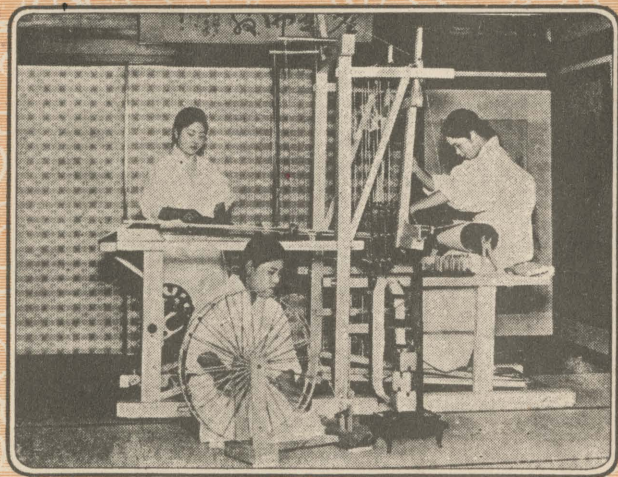

1889. February 10 to 12 the city was gay with arches of evergreens, flags, lanterns, dancing-stages, and so forth. The Government presented caps, dress piece-goods, and money to 673 octogenarians and to 10 nonagenarians in the city of Tokyo, while many convicts were liberated by the clemency of the Emperor on the occasion.
