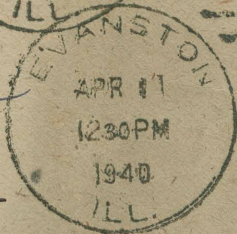

worry about any of it.

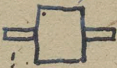
Don't try to write all your friends - that uses
